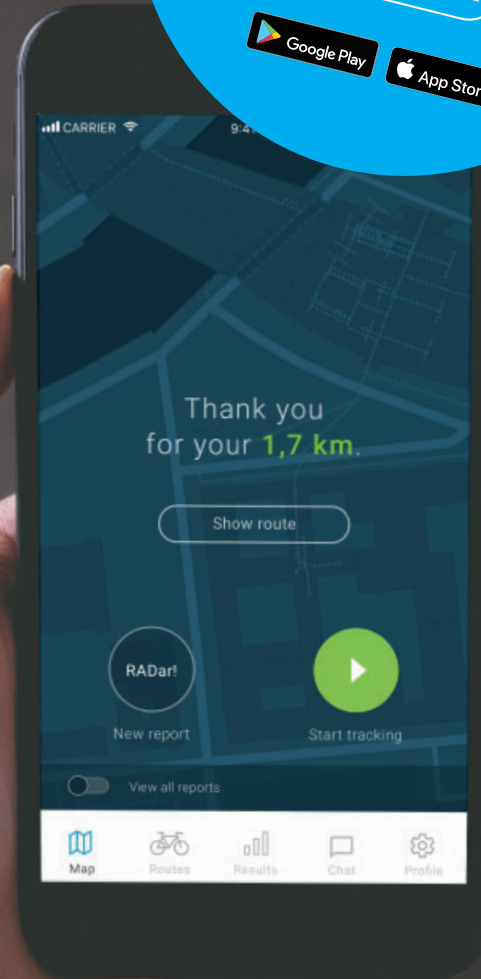

What's it all about?

Cycle for 21 days to promote cycling, help protect our climate and improve the quality of life in your municipality! Collect kilometres for your team and municipality. Whether you're cycling to work or in your leisure time – the goal is CO2-free travel! It's well worth taking part – many of the participating municipalities offer some great prizes and awards.

How can I get involved?

Register for your municipality on city-cycling.org, then join an existing team or form your own – after that, you can get cycling! Track the kilometres you cycle online or use the CITY CYCLING app to track your journeys.

Who can participate?

Local politicians and citizens as well as anyone who works, belongs to a club or attends school or university in the participating municipality.

When can I get involved?

Every year, from 1 May to 30 September on 21 consecutive days. Your municipality will set the dates for the local campaign.
