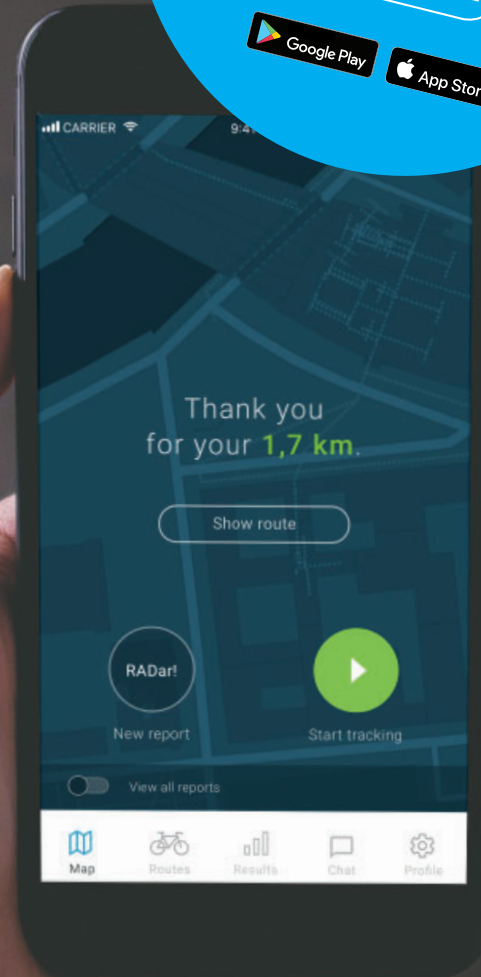

## What's it all about?

Cycle for 21 days to promote cycling, help protect our climate and improve the quality of life in your municipality! Collect kilometres for your team and municipality. ## How can I get involved?

Register for your municipality on [city-cycling.org](http://city-cycling.org), then join an existing team or form your own – after that, you can get cycling! Track the kilometres you cycle online or use the CITY CYCLING app to track your journeys.

## Who can participate?

Local politicians and citizens as well as anyone who works, belongs to a club or attends school or university in the participating municipality.

## When can I get involved?

Every year, from 1 May to 30 September on 21 consecutive days. Your municipality will set the dates for the local campaign.
