WHAT IS RADAR!

When shards of glass or tree roots leave you swerving, unlit routes become a hazard at night or cycle paths suddenly end, RADar! helps. Citizens can report issues by dropping pins on a digital map so that the municipality knows exactly where it needs to take action.



WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

Simply register in the **app** or on **radar-online.net**. If you have a CITY CYCLING account, you can use it to log in.

HOW CAN I SUBMIT A REPORT?

Drop a pin on the map in the app or on the website and, should you wish, also add a photo and description. Then submit it – and that's it!



... THEN WHAT HAPPENS?

Your municipality will immediately be notified of your report and can take care of the issue(s) you've raised. The report and processing status are publicly visible. This direct communication between municipalities and cyclists allows everyone to work together to improve the local cycling infrastructure.
